This multi year licensing agreement involves direct software sales, annual maintenance and remote upload fees. This is the second installation of GC3 globally and the first one in Canada and represents an expansion of offering from MS and SQL versions of GEMST™.

CardioComm is the first company to provide a real-time means of viewing EKGs over a network (LAN, WAN or Internet). This tool enables EKGs to be viewed and controlled live, by physicians, over a global virtual healthcare network. This technology is marketed as Global EKG Management System (GEMST™) and GlobalCardio™. CardioComm's software products have been cleared for sale in the United States by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. The Company has earned the latest ISO 13485 certification.
